

What is the prerequisite for NETA's Wellness Coach Specialty Certification?

To be eligible for NETA's Wellness Coach Specialty Certification, candidates must hold (1) current NCCA-accredited health or fitness certification, or (2) bachelor's degree or higher in a health or fitness-related field, or (3) credential/license as an allied health professional.

Have I fulfilled the prerequisite for NETA's Wellness Coach Specialty Certification???

Anyone is welcome to attend the Wellness Coach Specialty Certification Workshop to earn the continuing education credits (CECs). However, NETA will only grant the Wellness Coach Specialty Certification to those who have: 1) successfully passed the certification exam, AND 2) have fulfilled the prerequisite.

- Doctor of Chiropractic (D.C.)
- Physical Therapist (PT)
- Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA)
- Registered Nurse (RN)
- Licensed Nurses (LPN, LVN)
- Doctor of Podiatric Medicine (DPM)
- Medical and Nursing Specialties (multiple)
- Licensed Psychologist
